LATIN AMERICAN & CARIBBEAN STUDIES APPLICATION FOR LANGUAGE EXAMINATION FEE SUPPORT

The Center for Latin American Studies will cover the exam fee for a limited number of LACS graduate certificate applicants to take the Practical Language Proficiency Assessment or the Advanced Language Proficiency Assessment administered by the Chicago Language Center.

Note: Students in the Humanities Division are not required to pay the exam fee and thus should not submit this application.

CLAS requires that all students who apply for language exam support first meet with LACS program adviser Diana Schwartz Francisco to discuss their interest in the certificate and plans for completion.

CLAS will make awards on a rolling basis and will begin accepting applications in Week 1 of Autumn Quarter for applicants who plan to take the assessment in the Autumn, and Week 1 of Spring Quarter for those who take in the Spring. Applications must be submitted prior to the assessment. Submit application to clas@uchicago.edu.

Students who apply for language exam support are required to apply for the LACS graduate certificate. Awardees agree to submit an application for the LACS graduate certificate within 3 quarters of taking the exam or by their quarter of graduation, whichever comes sooner (e.g., a student who takes the exam in Autumn 2021 must apply for the certificate by Summer 2022).
